

RELINING YOUR CHIMNEY IS A FIVE STEP PROCESS

They are:

A) Home Protection: Drop cloths inside or exterior and moving of furniture or etc. to provide ample work space. Removing smoke pipe or other material around area, so the work can be done in a professional manner.

B) Set-up: Cleaning chimney, removal of damper, etc., scaffolding, grinding for tuck pointing, opening the chimney when necessary, (Assess parts) shoring up, etc.

C) Liner Placement: Set liner in place, clean up mixers, or pack tools in truck, reorganize and ready for clean-up.

D) Repair: Masonry repair, connections, thimbles or clean out doors installed, tuck pointing, rebuilding chimney tops, chimney crowns, etc.

E) Clean-up: Organize tools back in service vehicle. Vacuum areas where needed, clean off roof, remove scaffolding and drop cloths. Inspect area for cleanliness and correctness.
